

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2014, the City of Fairview municipal Planning Commission approved the final plat for the Hickory Springs subdivision on behalf of Walt Totty (developer); and

WHEREAS, the municipal Planning Commission of the City of Fairview made a favorable recommendation to the Board of Commissioners at the June 12, 2018, Planning Commission meeting to accept the Hickory Springs Subdivision;
