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Executive Summary

The Parks and Landscaping Board have worked with the Bowie Park Playground Rebuild Group (a citizens group) to explore and develop this proposal for a replacement playground at the City of Fairview's Bowie Park.

We present this proposal to the BOC for their review, consideration, and feedback.


If the City were to choose to pursue this path, the Playground Rebuild Group would shift their focus to the fundraising phase of the project.





- Day one safety certification with drop testing reports for the safety surfacing to be conducted by our Director of Safety, Ben Bowden.
- · Five Year Worry Free Plan that includes;

Yearly Maintenance Check.

Coverage for any missing or broken hardware.

Replacement of Swing Bushings during the initial 5 year period.

EWF surfacing top off every 18 months for the first 5 years.

 Along with the 5 year partner plan, we would like to extend an on call emergency labor option for any matters that fall outside of our included partner plan. The rate for a minimum of two laborers would be \$100.00/hour.

Estimated Maintenance:

30 minutes to 1 hour/month to rake mulch and perform a visual walk through for the life of the playground (recommended but optional).

Years 0-5 you have the partner program, manufacturer and labor backed warranties. Years 0-15 you have the manufacturer and labor backed warranties.

Approximately 4" mulch top off per 18 months after year 5. Approximately \$32/cubic yard - \$4200 per top off.

This starts at Day 1 as it includes a playground HIC test to give the City official documentation and peace of mind to know that from Day 1, their safety surfacing provides all the protection it is required to by the ASTM/CPSC guidelines. This also includes a full safety inspection by our Safety Director, Ben Bowden before the playground keys are turned over. Then, during the first 5 years, a Great Southern Representative will complete a Low-Frequency Audit and Maintenance Check of the Bowie Playground on its yearly anniversary. This inspection will provide the City with any maintenance/repair items that may need to be addressed and a solution for them. Additionally, we are including coverage of any missing or broken hardware (there's a lot of bolts on a playground that size!) at NO COST to the City. The swing bushings will likely need to be replaced every 2-3 years and Great Southern will include replacement of those bushings as necessary in the first 5 years of ownership. After 5 years, the City always has the option to purchase an extended maintenance agreement.

THREE (3) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

on all springs, moving swing parts, swing seats and other swing components, as well as all recycled plastic components against failure due to defects in materials or workmanship.

All warranties above commence on the date of the original invoice from Krauss Craft, Inc. 

Installations being not in direct contact with marine water but within 220 yards of a sea coast require extra maintenance. Regular documented evidence of washing down with clean water is required for a limited warranty to be considered.

Warranty Claims

To be valid, all warranty claims must be submitted in writing promptly following discovery of the defect(s) and within the specified warranty period. Berliner Seilfabrik requires that all warranty claims be accompanied by a copy of the original invoice and photograph(s) clearly identifying the defect(s) in question.

Product Replacement

Berliner Seilfabrik continually improves its products and equipment and reserves the right, when replacing products or parts, to make approved substitutions in design or specifications.

This warranty is valid only if the mounting/assembly and ground/foundation works are carried out as described in the Installation Instructions of your FHP products and maintained according to the maintenance instructions provided by FHP. For all warranty issues it is the responsibility of the customer to cover all shipping costs, when necessary, for warranty items. All replacement parts or products will be covered for the duration of the original warranty.

All products must be inspected immediately upon arrival. It is your responsibility to note any shipping damage on all copies of shipping paperwork. 12-14 weeks from time of order

Berliner net climber has a longer lead time (an additional 2-4 weeks) but we would normally begin installation on the rest of the equipment and install the rope climber when it arrives.

- Installation time about 4 weeks with decent weather could extend to 6 weeks if weather delay
- Play equipment layout and installation 2-4 weeks
- Border/Perimeter construction and rubber surfacing substrate 1 week
- Rubber Surfacing and wood mulch installation 1 week

Phased Build Timeline

Community Build Scenario - Construction Options

Community Build Info



We are enclosing 3 different construction options for each included design:

- 1) Base Quote The first quote is a fully turn-key build price where our in-house construction crew provides all the labor, materials and machinery to complete the playground installation, from safety surfacing to play equipment. All you have to do is give us access to the park!
- 2) Partial Community Build The second pricing scenario gives a deduct for a 'Partial Community Build'. This scenario could be done in a variety of ways, but for the purpose of pricing the RFP, we are proposing that the Partial Community Build conist of Great Southern installing all of the major equipment footers, tall towers/roofs and anything heavy enough for the City of Fairview to not want liability for. Great Southern would oversee a 3-day volunteer weekend (Fri/Sat/Sun) where community volunteers could sign up for a 4 hour shift to work on the playground build (8AM-12PM and 1PM-5PM shifts). This would be a great way for the community to have some 'sweat equity' and communal involvement in the new playground but also distance the City from liability of the heavy construction items on the playground. The scope of the community build days would include moving and installing loose fill wood mulch, installing individual play components (panels, slides and climbers), hanging/setting swings and assembling benches/tables. In this scenario, the volunteer group would be responsible for providing minimal equipment on the community build days, mostly limited to wheelbarrels, shovels, rakes, hammers and drills, basic tools most any citizen would already have.
- 3) Full Community Build The third pricing scenario gives a deduct for a 'Full Community Build'. In this scenario, Great Southern would only provide 2-3 of our installation crew members to help guide the volunteer group through the installation process. Great Southern would provide a schedule of work to be done and organize volunteer sign ups. Great Southern would also ensure that the installation work is done to manufacturer's specifications and meets the requirements of the ASTM/CPSC and ADA guidelines. A sample schedule and list of materials/construction machinery to be provided by the volunteer group is listed on the following page. If the City is capable of having all of these items donated, this along with volunteer labor, could provide monetary savings that would allow for additional playground equipment. However, Great Southern Recreation will not be able to extend the labor warranty (the manufacturer's warranties would remain intact). It is possible that if the City ands up having to pay for materials and machine rentals out of pocket, they might not find the increased liability and strain on local resources worth the effort of the full community build. But, we are happy to help assess this further with you.

The full community build option would still include Great Southern installing any poured rubber or artificial turf safety surface. It is important to note that in addition to the concrete requirements, heavy and light equipment requirements and volunteer labor, the City would also be responsible for survey and location of the equipment footer posts.
