5. Discuss and/or Take Action on Bill #2013-05, Ordinance No. 800 – An Ordinance to Amend City of Fairview, TN, Municipal Code, Title 8, “Alcoholic Beverages,” chapter 2, “Beer,” Sections 8-220 and 8-222. “Prohibited Conduct or Activities by Beer Permit Holders and Suspension and Revocation of Beer Permits.” Chairman Sutton read the caption. Mayor Totty made a motion for approval. Commissioner Bissell seconded. Attorney Cantrell stated that this is basically for housekeeping to bring us up to state standards, one of the things is that before we were limited to fine \$1,500, this will bring us up to \$2,500 and updated the ‘Responsible Vendors’ standards. Chairman Sutton asked Attorney Cantrell to look into one of the liquor stores that had gone through the responsible vendors program but was refused his ABC card. All were in favor of the motion.
