C. Resolution 13-25, A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Fairview, Tennessee, authorizing the Mayor to execute the Subdivision Development Agreement Contract for Woodwick Subdivision Phase 1. (City Engineer)

**Staff Report:** City Engineer Curtis Broadbent stated this subdivision development agreement for Woodwick Subdivision Phase 1 consists of 23 residential lots (lots 1-23). Mr. Broadbent stated the required bonds include a site reclamation bond in the amount of \$509,185.00 and a site performance bond in the amount of \$1,960,731.00.

**Discussion:** Commissioner Roberts expressed concerns over road improvements in this area due to several developments being constructed very close to one another. Mr. Broadbent stated there are plans for future road improvements in this area and Mr. Greer showed a diagram of the proposed future improvements and showed the construction entrance and route for construction traffic into the development. Commissioner Roberts also expressed concerns over wetlands being disturbed during development and asked what the consequences are for that. Mr. Broadbent replied a penalty or fine can be issued by TDEC. Commissioner Roberts asked what steps the city is taking to insure compliance of the rules. Mr. Broadbent replied city officials are doing everything they can to insure compliance however TDEC inspects the site and any penalties or violations will be assessed by TDEC.
