1. Call to order by Mayor Carroll at 6:07 p.m.
2. Discuss parameters for ordinances to prevent door to door calling by for-profit business after 6:00 p.m. and prohibiting the delivery of flyers, phone books, etc. by placing those items in driveways (newspapers excluded). These items were introduced by Commissioner Bissell at the March 17, 2016 Board of Commissioners meeting and it was decided this item needed more discussion. Key discussion points from the workshop include:
  - Solicitation
    - All door to door sales from for-profit groups should get a license,
    - Acceptable times are from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm and not allowed on Sunday
    - Exemptions for licensing are noted for non-profit groups
    - Enforcement would be carried out by the Codes and Police Departments
    - Politicians are not included due to the fact they have their own strict regulations about signs, etc.
  - Delivery of Unsolicited Publications
    - The issue with these publications is they tend to sit where they are dropped and create litter
    - A proposed "no delivery list" would be available to those wishing to opt out and would be maintained by the city
    - Enforcement would be carried out by the Codes Department
