A. City Manager Report – City Manager Scott Collins notes he emailed board members a monthly finance report this week and we will have a follow up discussion at the next work session. All

revenues and expenditures are listed by budget line item and department. Monthly postings to the website will begin in July to include the annual budget, monthly report and monthly cash account balances. We will review these items broadly once a month at a BOC meeting. Keep in mind that the monthly finance reports, especially year end, does not reflect the year end audit numbers. This is because the audit numbers are calculated on an accrual basis and we utilize cash accounting in our budget. While most of our revenue is calculated monthly, sales tax dollars come in 60 days behind, so the April report would show consumer spending from February. The second reading on the budget is in the consent agenda and reflects no property tax increase and our April report shows the city's reserve fund healthy at \$700,000 (funded 18 months ahead of schedule).
