1. Call to order by Mayor Totty at 7:02 p.m.

- Mayor Totty states the purpose of this public hearing is for citizen's comments on: CITY OF FAIRVIEW, TENNESSEE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2014.
 - <u>Donna Brooks</u> states that we can't change our current position but we can move toward a solution. She continued that we have a cash flow problem and challenged the citizens to show what a sense of community really means by donating \$100 per family to an emergency fund and to pay property taxes as soon as the statement is received in October.
 - <u>Bob Brooks</u> shares that we can't change where we are now but asks the Board to look at history and not repeat the same problems noting that the City has depleted close to \$2 million in reserves the last three years. He states that fiscal irresponsibility coupled with life happening are what led us here and that the little things add up in the long run. He asks them to heed lessons learned in this next budget.
