Mayor Brison called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.
A. The Prayer and Pledge to the Flag were led by Donn Lovvorn.

2. Approval of the Agenda –

- A. Mangrum made a motion to approve the Agenda as presented. Johnson seconded the motion. All were in favor.

- 6. Approval of the Minutes -
 - A. Presented for approval were the minutes of the Board of Commissioners Meeting held on August 21, 2008. Mangrum made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Hall seconded the motion. All were in favor.

7. Old Business –

- A. Presented for Second and Final Reading was Bill #2008-27: Rezoning of property located at 1391 Highway 96 North, Map 18, Parcel 22.02, from RS-40 to CG – Jimmy and Barbara Hudgins, Owners. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to approve Bill #2008-27 on second and final reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- B. Presented for Second and Final Reading was Bill #2008-28: Rezoning property located at 7100 Sleepy Hollow Road, Map 69, Parcel 56.00 from RS-40 to CG (Commercial General) Hazel E. Hutcherson, Owner. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to approve Bill #2008-28 on second and final reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- C. Presented for First Reading was Bill #2008-31: Rezoning of property located on Hwy.100, Map 42, Parcel 168.01 from AR-15 to PUD (Town Center Overlay District Main Street Mixed Use) PUD TCOD/MSMU City of Fairview, Owner. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to approve Bill #2008-31 on first reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.

- D. Presented for adoption was Resolution No. 34-08 to set the date of October 2, 2008 for a Public Hearing on the Rezoning of Map 42, Parcel 168.01. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 34-08. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- E. Presented for First Reading was Bill #2008-32: Rezoning of property located on Hwy. 100, Map 42, Parcel 169.00 from RS-40 to PUD (Town Center Overlay District Main Street Mixed Use) PUD TCOD/MSMU Kenneth and Helen Brison, Owners. Mayor Brison stated that he would recuse himself from discussion and voting on this issue. Vice-Mayor Johnson read the caption and made a motion to pass Bill #2008-32 on first reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. Vice-Mayor Johnson asked for the vote. For: Johnson, Mangrum, Arney and Hall. Abstain: Brison. Motion carried.
- F. Presented for adoption was Resolution No. 35-08 to set the date of October 2, 2008 for a Public Hearing on the Rezoning of Map 42, Parcel 169.00. Vice-Mayor Johnson read the caption and made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 35-08. Mangrum seconded the motion. Vice-Mayor Johnson asked for the vote. For: Johnson, Mangrum, Arney and Hall. Abstain: Brison. Motion carried.
- G. Presented for First Reading was Bill #2008-33: Rezoning of property located on Hwy. 100, Map 42, Parcel 169.01 from CG to PUD (Town Center Overlay District Main Street Mixed Use) – PUD – TCOD/MSMU – Elizabeth Binkley, Owner. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to pass Bill #2008-33 on first reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- H. Presented for adoption was Resolution No. 36-08 to set the date of October 2, 2008 for a Public Hearing on the Rezoning of Map 42, Parcel 169.01. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 36-08. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- Presented for First Reading was Bill #2008-34: Rezoning of property located on Hwy. 100, Map 42, Parcel 169.02 from RS-40 to PUD (Town Center Overlay District Main Street Mixed Use) – PUD – TCOD/MSMU – Charles and Jimmie Mangrum, Owners. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to pass Bill #2008-34 on first reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- J. Presented for adoption was Resolution No. 37-08 to set the date of October 2, 2008 for a Public Hearing on the Rezoning of Map 42, Parcel 169.02. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 37-08. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- K. Presented for First Reading was Bill #2008-35: Rezoning of property located on Hwy. 100, Map 42, Parcel 170.00 from CG to PUD (Town Center Overlay District Main Street Mixed Use) – PUD – TCOD/MSMU – Dianna Hughes and Jerry Lampley, Owners. Johnson read the caption and made a motion to pass Bill #2008-35 on first reading. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- L. Presented for adoption was Resolution No. 38-08 to set the date of October 2, 2008 for a Public Hearing on the Rezoning of Map 42, Parcel 170.00. Johnson read the caption and made a motion adopt Resolution No. 38-08. Mangrum seconded the motion. There was a question about the acreage in the property. Cantrell stated that he would check and correct it before the second and final reading. Vote on motion. All were in favor.

- M. Discuss erosion problem with owners of property in front of city hall Commissioner Mangrum advised that the property owners were not present. City Planner Donn Lovvorn advised that they were sent registered letters asking them to be present.
- N. Discuss and/or take action on the use of above ground Diesel and Gas Tanks City Mgr. Forehand advised that she is still concerned about the four year contract. Ricky Campbell representing J.B. Weimar, Inc. was present to answer questions from the Board. He advised that they would like to put a 2,000 gallon gas tank and a 560 gallon diesel tank at the Public Works Dept. A discussion followed which included the 560 gallon diesel tank being sufficient. Mayor Brison asked Public Works Director Wade Hooper for his opinion on the tanks. Hooper suggested that maybe they should use the diesel tank for a period of time and it if works out then add the gasoline tank. Johnson made a motion to approve installing a 1,000 gallon diesel tank and a 2,000 gallon gas tank at the Public Works Dept. with the discretion of the Public Works Director when the gas tank should be installed. Arney seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- O. Accept Bid on Backhoe City Mgr. Forehand advised that the backhoe was rebid with all bidders using the same specifications. (see copy of attached bids) She recommended that the bids not be accepted at this time and at the recommendation of Commissioner Arney they would like to have Diamond Equipment, Inc. (Case), Nortrax (John Deere) and Thompson Machinery (Caterpillar) bring their backhoes out so that they can be tested. Arney made a motion to not accept a bid at this time. Hall seconded the motion. All were in favor. Hall asked if the bids will hold until the testing is done. Forehand stated that they would.

Johnson made a motion to ask city attorney to prepare the necessary ordinance. Mangrum seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- *(3)* Amend the City of Fairview Zoning Ordinance by providing for the implementation of the newly adopted Subdivision Regulations. Johnson read the caption of Bill #2008-36 and made a motion to pass it on first reading and to set the date of October 2nd for a Public Hearing. Hall seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- B. Discuss and/or take action on a Master Plan for Bowie Nature Park Commissioner Mangrum made a motion to defer Item B and Item C until the September 18th Board Meeting and to discuss Item C first. Johnson seconded the motion. All were in favor.
