1. Call to order by City Manager Collins at 6:00 p.m.

2. Items of Discussion -

- Item 12A needs to be removed from tonight's agenda and will be on the next meeting agenda.
- Revised agenda format was presented by Collins who noted the order was established by ordinance and
 must be amended by ordinance. This is a matter of housekeeping to clean up the agenda. Staff departmental
 reports would be presented once a month and the financial report presented at the second meeting of the
 month. Collins also suggests incorporating a blank voting record with the agenda so everyone can keep up
 during the meeting.
- Motorola radios resolution presented tonight does not include funding as we have several options including local banks, lease/purchase or cash. We have until February to make the funding decision but if we approve the purchase order before November 17 it saves us \$17,000. This is a sole source state bid purchase.
- Facilities fund our auditors have concern that our facilities tax is tied to building permit applications and the codified use of an undependable resource and the use of these funds in a segregated class. They suggested the facilities tax become part of the permit fees by abolishing the existing facilities tax ordinance and consider the facilities tax fee as a resolution. Revenue from the existing tax is required to be in a separate fund.
- Road striping the need to re-stripe several areas has been brought up and we are working on some budget
 pricing for this. Commissioner Burks brought up the question of the cost of a striping machine and whether
 it might be worth purchasing. Collins will check into this.
- Fee structure changes for the planning department such as pre-paid engineering fees included with the permit fee rather than billing the developer after the fact.
