Williamson County GREENWAYS PLAN



Williamson County is excited to launch the countywide **Multi-modal Greenways Plan**, a transformative initiative aimed at creating a safe, accessible, and connected multi-modal network of greenways with a focus on creating **connections in unincorporated areas of the county**. The plan envisions an integrated greenway system that supports **alternate forms of transportation**, **links neighborhoods**, **schools**, **parks**, and **key destinations**, **while preserving the county's natural beauty and cultural heritage**.

This planning effort is federally funded through the **Safe Streets for All (SS4A) grant program**, which supports projects that **enhance pedestrian and cyclist safety, improve mobility, and reduce roadway conflicts**. In addition to the Multi-modal Greenways Plan, Williamson County is also working on a separate, but coordinated planning effort, the Countywide Safety Action Plan, which will focus on improving roadway safety, including reducing and eliminating serious-injury and fatal crashes affecting all roadway users.
